RE: File 190719 – Ordinance amending the Planning Code to establish the Accelerating Affordable Housing and Affordable Teacher Housing Program

Dear Ms. Calvillo,

Should the proposed ordinance be approved by the voters, in my opinion, it would have a minimal impact on the cost of government.

The proposed ordinance establishes the Accelerating Affordable Housing and Affordable Teacher Housing Program to facilitate construction and development of housing projects for residents earning up to 140 percent of Area Median Income. The ordinance defines affordable teacher housing projects as those where no less than two-thirds of units are occupied by at least one employee of the San Francisco Unified School District or Community College District. The ordinance also specifies zoning modifications for these housing projects, including priority processing to accelerate developments, form based density and height allowances.

To the extent that this legislation shortens this process, the City's affordable housing projects could see cost savings due to shorter development and construction timelines and lower inflation on project costs.
