

Figure 2: Within Three Weeks After the Audit Started, More Pages Mysteriously Vanished from LHH's Web Site

 The cover of this slide show illustrates that the "Vision Statement" page for the Laguna Honda Foundation has gone missing, as has its "Research Programs" web page.

- Why did both pages vanish during an audit of LHH's patient gift fund that reportedly began on September 1?
- Coincidence? Or did the auditors find that hosting web pages for a non-profit may not be permissible?
- Are the missing pages being re-written?


Figure 3: The Foundation's "Vision Statement" Had Been Available on September 10

 "Research Programs" pages
 simply edited, not removed?
