## The Methodology for Creating New "Staff Development Accounts" Is Flawed; They Should Be Based on <u>Actual</u> Staff Donations and Not Moved Into LHH's Hospital Operations Account

- On May 11, three of the staff education accounts were suddenly awarded \$89,998 in interest, on only \$33,519 in principal in the accounts, pushing the total staff education accounts to \$123,517l, little of which came from donations <u>for</u> staff.
- Why should the new account be based on receipts initially intended for patients, instead of the receipts that were actually earmarked for staff?
- And shouldn't the interest be returned to patient benefit?

There are no specific "planned appropriations". Rather, the amounts for employee development will be based on the current balances, which will be transferred out of the gift fund into an account within the Laguna Honda fund. Any future additional sources to the employee development account will be based on actual receipts of donations for this purpose.
