


Table of Non-Filer's on Ethics Commission Web Site

As of Wednesday, August 6 at 11:41 p.m., the table below on the Ethics Commission web site had not contained any notes in the "Notes" column for any of the five non-filers. The note for Mr. Pilpel appears to have been added on either August 7 or August 8 following a records request placed on August 7 for the paper copy that the FPPC reported on August 5 was in the possession of the Ethics Commission.

As of August 8, the Ethics Commission has offered:

- No explanation of what the "unresolvable complication" with Pilpel's Form 700 involves, and no explanation of why the matter cannot be resolved given the fact that the Ethics Commission appears to have had Pilpel's Form 700 since April 14;
- No explanation of why the paper copy that was scanned to PDF format and provided on August 8 in response to a public records request cannot be uploaded to the Ethics Commission web site, removing Pilpel from the list of non-filers;
- No explanation as to why Pilpel remains on the on-line Form 700 Non-Filers List, considering that his Form 700 was date-stamped as received by the Ethics Commission on April 14, 2014, fully four months ago;
- No explanation as to why Pilpel remained on the Non-Filers List for four months after the Form 700 was date-time stamped as received by Ethics on April 14, or where the Form 700 has been at Ethics all this time;
- No explanation of whether Pilpel was required to pay, or has paid, a late filing fee;
- No explanation of whether the Ethics Commission has closed its own potential enforcement proceeding against Mr. Pilpel and
- No explanation as to why the scanned-to-PDF Form 700 has not been uploaded to the SEI searchable database so members of the public can easily access it along with Mr. Pilpel's other previous on-line SEI records.
