On April 27, 2012, Mr. Todd David submitted an application to the San Francisco Board of Supervisors for an appointment to San Francisco's Sunshine Ordinance TaskForce (SOTF). On the same date he submitted a signed FPPC Form 700, which potentially contains a number of errors. First, on the Form 700, in Section 3, Type of Statement, he indicated it was an "Annual" submission, rather than as an "Assuming Office" statement, that he should have checked as an appointee assuming a new office. Second, although Mr. David checked on the Form 700 cover page that he was attaching a Schedule B, Real Property form, he instead submitted a typed statement in lieu of the required Schedule B form. Third, Mr. David did not submit either a Schedule A-1 or Schedule A-2 itemizing Investments, despite the fact that on the application he submitted to the Board of Supervisors for appointment to the SOTF he listed his business or professional experience that he is an "investor." A Google search shows Mr. David to be the "General Partner" of Lion Hill Partnership, LP, which the California Secretary of State's web site lists as a current, active business entity. Description, With as Much Particularity as Possible, of Facts Constituting Alleged Violation and how you have personal knowledge that it occurred**

First, it is potentially odd that an investor would have no investments to report on Schedule A-1 or A-2, and submitted neither applicable schedule, particularly since Mr. David is listed as the "General Partner" of Lion Hill Partnership. Second, there does not appear to be any provision that individuals required to complete Form 700 are permitted to substitute typed statements in lieu of the required supplemental schedules (i.e., Mr. David's typed statement in lieu of of Schedule "B"). Members of local boards and commissions are required to complete Form 700 in San Francisco. My personal knowledge that a potential violation may have occurred is the result of records requests I placed with the Clerk of the Board of San Francisco's Board of Supervisors, as shown in the following attachments: Attachment 3: Sunshine Task Force Administrator Andrea Ausberry's July 13 response to, and my initial July 11 request for, the Form 700's for the newly-appointed Task Force members. Ms. Ausberry is employed by the Clerk of the Board and assigned to the SOTF. Attachment 4: My July 14 follow up e-mail to Ms. Ausberry requesting the required Schedule B pre-printed form for Mr. David, and Ms. Ausberry's July 17 e-mail response stating that "if and when" San Francisco's Ethics Commission rejects Mr. David's initial typed statement in lieu of Schedule B "formal" form, she will forward it to me. **Please attach copies of any available documentation that is evidence of the violation, (for example, checks, campaign materials, etc., if applicable to the complaint). Note that a newspaper article is **NOT** considered evidence of a violation.
